POLITICAL COUPLE KICK-OFF 'POLITINI' WEB SERIES ON THEGRIO.COM 8-week run begins February 26 and will feature unique blend of politics and pop culture

WASHINGTON, D.C.— Married Politicos Danielle and Aisha Moodie-Mills of the weekly politics and pop culture talk show, *Politini*, are expanding their popular podcast from the airwaves to video with the production of a new series for the Grio.com.

FIRE explores the policy intersections of race, class, gender, and sexuality. In addition, they appear regularly on MSNBC offering political commentary as guests on a variety of shows including the "Melissa Harris-Perry Show", "Jansing & Co" and "Up with Steve Kornacki."
