Aisha Moodie-Mills is a progressive strategist, policy analyst, and social entrepreneur with over a decade of experience in federal politics and policy. She is currently a Senior Fellow at the Center for American Progress where she directs the Fighting Injustice to Reach Equality (FIRE) initiative which examines the policy intersections of race, gender and sexuality. She has been recognized as one of The Root's top 100 African American trailblazers, and as a "Forty Under 40" national LGBT leader by the Advocate magazine. She serves on the board of Choice USA.

Aisha's work and publications have been featured in a variety of media outlets including: The Atlantic, Black Enterprise, Washington Post, Essence, POLITICO, Ebony, Huffington Post, and Uptown Magazine, and she also appears regularly as a political commentator on MSNBC's Melissa Harris-Perry Show, MSNBC Live, Jansing & Co, and The Daily Rundown.

She made numerous headlines as a key strategist and spokesperson for the campaign that brought marriage equality to the District of Columbia, where she and her wife, Danielle, were among the first same-sex couples to receive a marriage license. Their wedding was also the first lesbian wedding featured by Essence. The couple produces and hosts *Politini*, a politics and pop culture show on blis.fm, and pen the lifestyle blog Living, Loving, and Laboring OUT Loud, or threeLOL.

Aisha was previously the Executive Director of the Congressional Black Caucus PAC; Regional Finance Director at the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee; and an independent consultant to a host of federal campaigns, Members of Congress, and advocacy organizations. She holds both a BA and MBA from the University of Maryland, College Park.
